Miriam Toews grew up in Steinbach, Manitoba, the second daughter of Mennonite parents, a heritage that has informed much of her work. She is the author of six bestselling novels: Summer of My Amazing Luck, A Boy of Good Breeding, A Complicated Kindness, The Flying Troutmans, Irma Voth, All My Puny Sorrows, and one memoir, Swing Low: A Life.



A former teacher and school principal, Dr. Steve Van Bockern is an eminent academic known for reaching out to The teaching, research, service and mentorship that Dr. Bill Rannie has provided over his 40-year career at The University of Winnipeg epitomizes what it means to be a professor at the institution. His involvement has spanned the entire scope of the University. He is a dedicated and accomplished scholar, having published many articles in both peer-reviewed journals and non-academic publications.

Under her guidance and via skillful negotiation with the Government of Manitoba, Mays brought full certification



A highly accomplished administrator, researcher and professor, Dr. Michael McIntyre is noted for his outstanding contributions while serving as Assistant Dean from 1978 to 1982, and Dean of Arts and Science from 1982 to 1992.

During the decade McIntyre served as Dean, virtually the entire University fell under the umbrella of the Faculty of Arts and Science. He impressed his colleagues with his ability to not only balance his many responsibilities which included oversight of the University's academic programs and its faculty, teaching, and his own research program — but to maintain an active role as a leader. Remarkably, in addition to performing duties that today are shared among several positions, McIntyre di erent national attention for the establishment of UWinnipeg's Centre for Academic Writing and developed an accessibility program for those with physical disabilities.

McIntyre also boosted the arts presence on campus by fostering the evolution of Theatre from a program to a department, and by establishing In-Residence programs for writers, directors and playwrights. Working collegially with the departments, he was able

For her outstanding contributions to the ethos of The University of Winnipeg, both inside and outside the classroom, Dr. Beverley Fehr receives the Cli ord Robson Award for Excellence in Teaching.

# Heather Whittaker

VALEDICTORIAN

Considered one of the top undergraduate students in Canada working in biomedical research, Heather Whittaker is described as "dynamite" and "explosively bright". She is a resourceful, driven, award-winning student with a passion and curiosity for neuroscience — particularly the physiology of the aging brain. She plans to become a practicing physician involved in clinical research, and wants to have direct involvement in the care of people with dementia.

Whittaker has spent her last two summers engaged in undergraduate research with a focus on Alzheimer's disease. She is currently working with Dr. Melanie Martin, Chancellor's Research Chair and Associate Professor of Physics at UWinnipeg, to develop new magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) methods for earlier diagnosis of Alzheimer's, a disease which a icts nearly 300,000 Canadians. Whitaker has published a paper with Martin and has a second one in the works, to be published in the fall.

Whittaker discovered her path by volunteering at Grace Hospital, which she still finds time for once a week. At Grace she

works with mostly older adult patients, many of whom have cognitive deficits, including dementia. This is where she observed how challenging it is to cope with such disorders, both for patients and their families. The experience sparked her interest in the aging brain and led her to a volunteer position with the Alzheimer Society of Manitoba.

Whittaker has earned more than a dozen awards and scholarships. Her long list includes the prestigious Isbister Undergraduate Scholarship; Gold Medal for Achievement in a Major (3-Year), Biopsychology; Chancellor's Gold Medal for the Highest Standing in Science (a medal for overall achievement in a 3-Year degree); and the Governor General's Silver Medal.

This fall, Whittaker heads to Europe to begin her Master's Degree and continue her research in clinical neuroscience at University College London, a world-class dementia research centre.





# Catherine van Reenen

Catherine van Reenen is graduating with a 4-yr Bachelor of Arts degree from the department of Rhetoric, Writing and Communications with a strong interest in religion, culture and philosophy.

# **ACADEMIC DRESS**

Academic dress originated in medieval times to provide warmth in the damp halls of learning. In its present form it includes a gown, hood (worn over the shoulders) and a cap or mortarboard. All universities have distinctive dress for each degree o ered, which explains the variety seen in the academic procession.

The University of Winnipeg academic dress conforms to the North American Intercollegiate Code. All graduates wear a black gown which varies according to the degree conferred. The bachelor's gown is worn closed in front and is distinguished by its pointed sleeves. The master's gown is designed to be worn either open or closed in front and has closed sleeves with an opening to free the hands. The front portion of the sleeve below the opening has a long semi-circular cut-out. Doctorate gowns also may be worn open or closed. They are faced with velvet.

The edging colour on the hood indicates the faculty in which a degree is conferred: Graduate Studies – red; Science – gold; Education – blue; Arts – white; Business & Economics – brown; Kinesiology - green. The width of edging is determined (h o)-0.9(f e5-17.
