

Dr Jack Zipes is a orld reno ned scholar of fair tale studies and childrens literature He is a strong contributor to the intellectual life of man communities including that of facult and students at The Uni ersit of Winnipeg

As Professor Emeritus Uni ersit of Minnesota Zipes is a multi lingual scholar hose academic career spans more than ears and includes the publication of books in English and German in addition to numerous essa s His impact is far reaching he shifted the eld of stud of traditional te ts directed to oung people ith his insight that folk and fair tales must be read ithin the historical economic social and cultural conte ts of their production His in uence has been felt b man at UWinnipeg here the stud of childrens literature has been an institutional strength for decades

Zipes isited UWinnipeg annuall from presenting ell attended public talks holding teach ins ith students and colleagues and tirelessl mentoring and supporting the academic journe s of others Most recentl he gifted his unique and rich collection of fair tale lms to The Uni ersit of Winnipeg librar the largest database of fair tale lms in the

orld This peerless collection of resource material cements UWinnipeg as the place to conduct research in this area

B tenaciousl championing the humanities and imagination as po erful forces in enabling social justice Zipes is an inspiration internationall The Uni ersit of Winnipeg is proud to present Dr Jack Zipes ith n i Dr Patricia Fit patrick has made signi cant contributions to en ironmental social and economic sustainabilit at The Uni ersit of Winnipeg and ithin the ider communit Her ork o er the last ears has focused on bhictal

Dr Narad Rampersad is a kno ledgeable and gifted researcher ith an e ceptional publication record ho has garnered international recognition for the qualit of his ork He is considered to be one of the best of his generation

His e pertise spans a ariet of areas in discrete mathematics including formal languages automata theor descriptional comple it pattern a oidance and number theor but is internationall reno ned for his research in combinatorics on ords the stud of patterns in sequences o er a nite set of s mbols

Rampersad is kno n for his cle er and intricate solutions to hard problems that others ha e been unable to sol e His postdoctoral fello ship at UWinnipeg ith Dr James Currie mathematics and statistics jointl resol ed the last remaining open cases of a long standing conjecture in combinatorics on ords kno n as Dejean's Conjecture The nal step to this solution represents one of the most important results in combinatorics on ears


