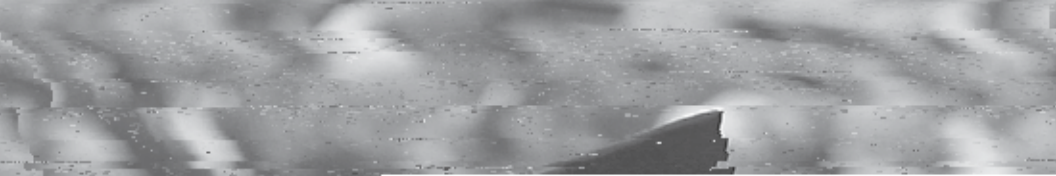

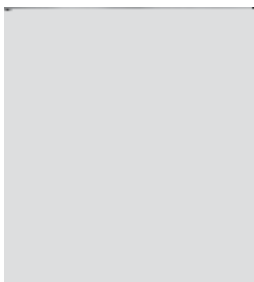

Sandra DeLaronde is a champion of social change who works tirelessly to amplify the voices of Indigenous people in Manitoba. Raised in a strong and vibrant Métis family, she is a member of Cross Lake First Nation with roots at the Métis settlement of Duck Bay.

A passionate community builder, DeLaronde has made it her life's work to end violence and support the families of Missing and Murdered Women, Girls, and 2-Spirited persons (MMIWG2S). As co-chair of Manitoba's MMIWG2S Coalition, she is a powerful voice for Manitoba families in the Commission of a National Inquiry into Murdered and Missing Indigenous Women, Girls and 2-Spirited Persons, ensuring the hearts of families and survivors are honoured and protected.

She played an instrumental role in developing and managing the Helen Betty Osborne Memorial Scholarship, which was established in 2000 to honour the life and legacy of its namesake, who was murdered in The Pas in 1976. This scholarship has delivered over \$1 million in direct bursary support to hundreds of First Nations, Métis, and Inuit students pursuing post-secondary education in Manitoba.

DeLaronde worked closely with The University of Winnipeg's Office of Indigenous Affairs to incorporate

Star Blanket teachings into the campus – integrating a Star Blanket mural on the Helen Betty Osborne building and as a theme throughout convocations and the Spring Feast.

DeLaronde is generous in sharing her knowledge and culture with others. As head woman for the Oyate Wiwanyang Wacipi (Sundance) and the Heart of the White Buffalo Moondance, she plays a vital role in strengthening Indigenous ceremony, practice, and tradition.

Whether heading a project or chairing a heated meeting of diverse perspectives, DeLaronde leads with a combination of authority, generosity, and empathy that bridges difficult conversations and influences change. This is evident in her work with national, provincial, and local women's and Aboriginal women's organizations in support of community development, cultural reclamation, and reconciliation.

For her dedication to amplifying the voices of the Indigenous community and her leadership in supporting the families of Missing and Murdered Women, Girls, and 2-Spirited persons, The University of Winnipeg proudly bestows an Honorary Doctor of Laws on Sandra DeLaronde.

Throughout a remarkable, varied, and decorated career, Thomas Denton has left an indelible mark on the city, province, and country in myriad ways, none greater than his ceaseless efforts to improve the lives of the oppressed and marginalized who have sought a higher station of life in Canada.

A graduate of Acadia University and Dalhousie University's School of Law, Denton found his calling in 1984 when the International Centre of Winnipeg sought to replace its executive director. Denton – who served 14 years in the Royal Canadian Naval Reserves, from which he retired as Lieutenant-Commander and for which he received the Canadian Forces Decoration – assumed the role and became the face of refugee sponsorship in Manitoba.

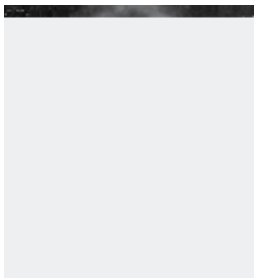
Through his work, he helped reshape Winnipeg's downtown core into one of the most welcoming and culturally diverse in Canada, created transitional housing for those arriving in the city, and doggedly fought for government support of subsidized housing. But Denton was more than a behind-the-scenes figure to those he helped. He has been personally involved in the settling of more than 40,000 individuals in Canada and has at times been a one-man welcoming committee –

on hand to greet many of those whose first destination was Winnipeg. After departing International Centre of Winnipeg at the turn of the millennium, Denton continued his work as a policy consultant and as executive director of the non-government organization Hospitality House Refugee Ministry.

Denton has been an integral contributor to the arts community in Winnipeg. In 1980, following the closure of the *Winnipeg Tribune*, he became the founding publisher of the *Winnipeg Sun*, a post he retained until its sale in 1983. Additionally, he was among the trustees who successfully endeavoured to save the Winnipeg Symphony. A generous volunteer who served on numerous committees, commissions, and boards – including those of the Prairie Theatre Exchange, Stage West, Royal Manitoba Theatre Centre, Walker Theatre, and Manitoba Museum – Denton was also the first chairperson of the City of Winnipeg Arts Council.

For his tireless commitment to humanitarian efforts and advocacy for human rights, in addition to his services to Winnipeg's arts community, The University of Winnipeg proudly bestows an Honorary Doctor of Laws on Thomas Denton.

For more than 40 years, Dr. Patricia Parker has been a dedicated and innovative educator, academic, scholar, and author. Her ties to The University of Winnipeg date back to 1967, when she graduated from United College. After receiving her MA in English at the University of Toronto, Parker taught for three years in Tanzania as a CUSO volunteer, first for the Ministry of Education and then as a lecturer at the University of East Africa. After completing her PhD in Comparative Literature at Yale, she returned to the University of Toronto where she taught for 11 years.

In 1986, she was invited to Stanford as Visiting Professor and has been a permanent professor at the institution in English and Comparative Literature since 1988.

Parker is the author of four books: *Inescapable Romance: Studies in the Poetics of a Mode*; *Literary Fat Ladies: Rhetoric, Gender, Property, Shakespeare from the Margins: Language, Culture, Context*; and *Shakespearean Intersections: Language, Contexts, Critical Keywords*. She's also the co-editor of five collections of essays covering criticism, theory, race, and cultural studies.

Known as one of the most original interpreters of Shakespeare, Parker's *Shakespeare from the Margins* placed her at the centre of Shakespearean studies after insisting his language must be interpreted from diverse perspectives, including race, religion, sexuality, and gender. UWinnipeg English Chair Brandon Christopher said

that Parker's third book "cemented her reputation as one of the most important and insightful scholars in Shakespeare studies," while her fourth book "is dazzling in its clarity and its ambition, taking the reader on a seamless exploration of both the specificity of language as it was used in Shakespeare's plays and the complex web of culture out of which that language emerged."

Parker has made it her mission to bring literature to those outside the university by organizing public festivals and working with students to create performance-based programs within the community. Most notably, she's the editor of the nearly two-million-word *Stanford Global Shakespeare Encyclopedia*, which will be launched in 2021-22 as an open-access online resource for students, scholars, and the public.

A sought-after speaker, Parker has lectured all over the world, from France, Germany, and Spain, to Australia, New Zealand, and the Czech Republic. She has also been a Gauss Seminar lecturer at Princeton, was a Shakespeare's Birthday lecturer at Folger Shakespeare Library, and was named a Northrop Frye Professor in Literary Theory at the University of Toronto.

For her contribution to a generation of students, her masterful scholarship, and for championing the place of literature inside and outside post-secondary institutions, The University of Winnipeg is proud to bestow an Honorary Doctor of Laws on Patricia Parker.

Eliakim M. Sibanda is a globally acclaimed advocate for human rights, peace, and justice. His knowledge and community engagement have enriched the university community, our neighbourhoods, and beyond.

An eminently qualified intellectual, Sibanda has been pivotal in developing several notable Masters programs at UWinnipeg. He helped create The University of Winnipeg's Global College, helped establish the BA in Human Rights and Global Studies – the first in Western Canada – and was instrumental to the establishment of the Oral History Centre at UWinnipeg. He also played a pivotal role in establishing the joint UWinnipeg/

Dr. Anna Stokke is an ambassador for math education whose high standard of teaching and research inspires student success.

Her commitment to teaching excellence has been recognized with a series of awards, including most recently a 2021 3M National Teaching Fellowship – Canada's most prestigious recognition of excellence in post-secondary teaching and educational leadership. She balances innovative classroom teaching with community service, a high level of administrative leadership, NSERC-funded research, and media availability for interviews on math education.

Stokke is a gifted educator who goes out of her way to create an engaging atmosphere in which students excel. Whether mentoring advanced math majors undertaking complicated research projects or teaching first-year students, she incorporates techniques like scaffolding to introduce new concepts in incremental steps that allow students to experience success faster. On her public YouTube channel, she posts videos of herself working through math problems for viewing by her own students as well as those in other classes.

Stokke's passion for the material inspires students to become extremely engaged and work hard to succeed in her classes. "I lose track of time during her lectures," said

one of her students. "She makes extremely complicated material simple. She makes vague classroom

Often the first point of contact for Indigenous and international students beginning their studies at The University of Winnipeg, she is known for creating a warm, welcoming environment for students navigating a brand-new world.

Royden Loewen is a prolific scholar in the area of Mennonite history. His distinguished work in teaching, mentorship, and research, while serving as Chair in Mennonite Studies for over two decades, reflects his commitment to and extraordinary influence in his field of study. Loewen's vast range of scholarship delves into economics, gender, and religious life

Throughout her remarkable 45-year career, Judith Huebner made important, lasting contributions in teaching, research, and service.

Arriving at The University of Winnipeg in 1975, Huebner joined the Department of Biology as an instructor during a period of rapid curricular expansion. Over the decades, she took on many teaching roles across the curriculum, as well as coordination of the department's large first-year courses and four-year honours students' theses.

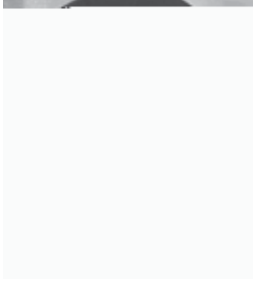
Former department Chair Ed Byard described Huebner as a "clear and committed voice in departmental matters." She was also deeply committed to self-governance and had a sterling record in administrative service: she held the role of Associate Dean of Arts and Science for six years starting in 1992, was Acting Dean in 1997, and served as special assistant to UWinnipeg President Constance Rooke from 1999 – 2002.

In 2002, Huebner returned to the Department of Biology as a professor before becoming Acting Chair of the Departments of Political Science and Women's and Gender Studies. Huebner once again returned to the Department of Biology in 2014, where she served as Chair until her retirement in June 2020.

Whether supporting students, faculty members, or staff, Huebner was committed to the advancement of women in academics. While attentiveness to women's issues may seem an inevitable part of our scholarly and social landscape now, that was far from the case in the early years of her feminist activism.

This integration of real-life activism and academic expertise is evidenced by Huebner's significant role in establishing the Prairie Regional Centre of Excellence for Women's Health, her long-standing service to the Women's Health Clinic, and her work on the advisory panels for the Institute of Women's and Gender Studies and the Margaret Lawrence Endowment for Women's Studies. She has also been a member of the NSERC selection review panel for the Chair in Women in Science and Engineering, and for over a decade was a board member of the Centre of Excellence in Women's Health.

The University of Winnipeg proudly honours Judith Huebner with Fellowship in United College for her distinguished career in academics, self-governance, and activism with board attentiveness to women's

Cain Kiddell envisions his future classroom as an inclusive learning environment where all students are empowered to thrive.

He spent his early twenties facilitating skateboard camps in Winnipeg's inner city, an experience that fueled his desire to become a teacher.

"The exposure to the systemic barriers that impact the individuals living in the inner-city inspired me to pursue a career where I can help address these problems," he said.

One of his most memorable university experiences was in a first-year earth science course with Dr. Ed Cloutis. The lecture began normally enough with Cloutis explaining about sedimentary layers of rocks and their physical and chemical properties.

"Then, mid-sentence, he takes the piece of chalk in his hand and begins to eat it, with no explanation, and carries on with the lesson," said Kiddell.

Kiddell went on to work in Cloutis's C-TAPE laboratory where he excelled as a research assistant. In this role, he engaged in field research locally and internationally and was first author on a research article in *The Journal of Geophysical Research*, as well as co-author of research articles in *Icarus* and *The Astronomical Journal*.

Years after their first meeting, Kiddell asked Cloutis about the chalk. He smiled and replied with a question of his own, "how do you get students to pay attention and remember you?"

As Kiddell gets set to embark on a career at the head of his own classroom, it's a lesson he will never forget.
