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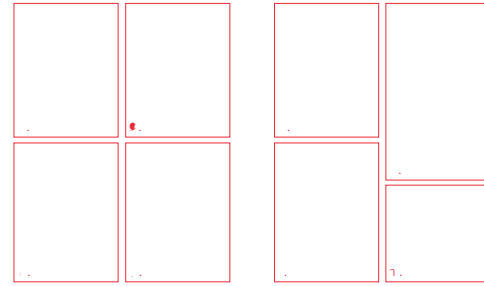

1. UWinnipeg Graduating Students' Experience

UWinnipeg's 2018 survey results (n=1,000) showed that 73% of students were satisfied with their experience.

2. Year 1 to Year 2 Retention

UWinnipeg's 2018 survey results (n=1,000) showed that 73% of students retained from Year 1 to Year 2. This is a significant improvement over previous years, with retention rates of 70% in 2016-17 and 71% in 2017-18.

3. Average 1st and 2nd Year Class Sizes

UWinnipeg's 2018 survey results (n=1,000) showed that the average class size for 1st and 2nd year students was 25. This is a decrease from 28 in 2016-17 and 27 in 2017-18.

4. Work-Integrated Learning

UWinnipeg's 2018 survey results (n=1,000) showed that 25% of students had completed a work-integrated learning experience. This is an increase from 16% in 2016-17 and 18% in 2017-18.

5. Undergraduate Degrees Conferred by Faculty

UWinnipeg's 2018 survey results (n=1,000) showed that 100% of students received an undergraduate degree from their faculty.

6. 7 Year Graduation Rate

UWinnipeg's 2018 survey results (n=1,000) showed that the 7-year graduation rate was 85%. This is a significant improvement over previous years, with rates of 78% in 2006-07, 80% in 2007-08, 82% in 2010-11, and 83% in 2017-18.

7. Delay in Program Completion

UWinnipeg's 2018 survey results (n=1,000) showed that 10% of students experienced a delay in program completion. This is a decrease from 15% in 2009, 12% in 2012, 14% in 2015, and 13% in 2018.

8. Debt from Financing Education

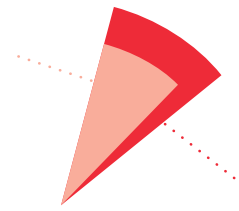
UWinnipeg's 2018 survey results (n=1,000) showed that 15% of students had debt from financing their education. This is a decrease from 20% in 2016-17 and 18% in 2017-18.

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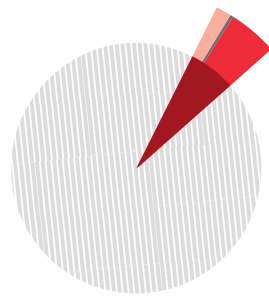
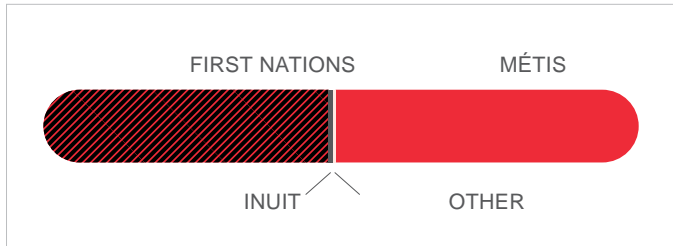
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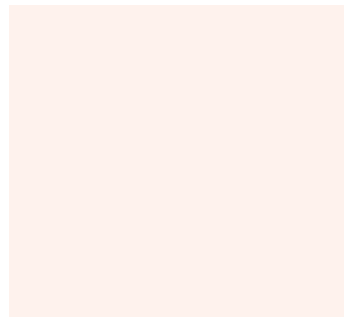


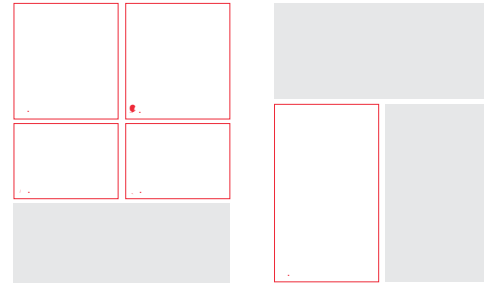

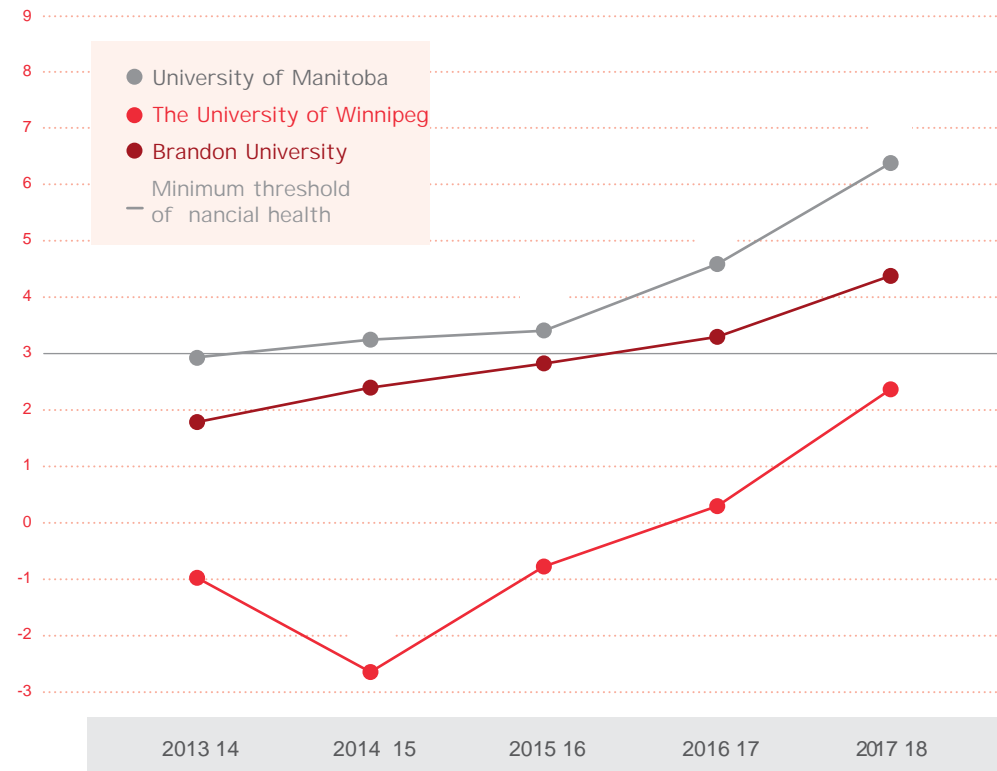

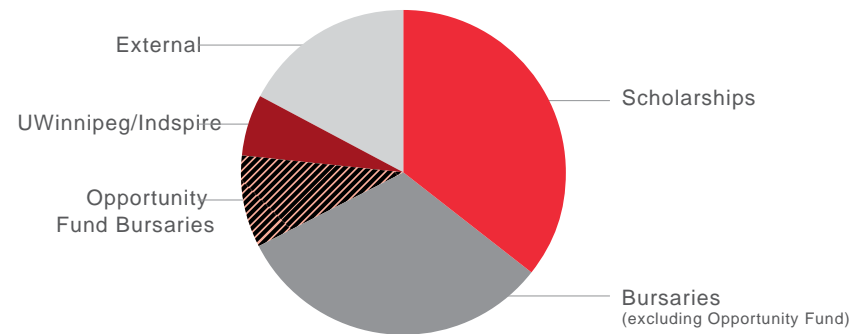




### Composite Financial Index (CFI)
