



Opening of the H. Sanford Riley Centre for Canadian History

October 19 marked the opening of the H. Sanford Riley Centre for Canadian History at the University of Winnipeg. The centre will collaborate with other historically-minded entities on campus: the Centre for Rupert's Land Studies, Canada's National History Society, the Oral History Centre, the Chair in German Canadian Studies, the Chair in Memoniue Studies, the Plett Foundation, the H. Sanford Riley Fellowship, the Centre for the Teaching of Manitoba History and the Canadian Oral History Association. The centre's opening was followed by its inaugural lecture, given by Ramsay Cook, Professor Emeritus of York University.

Profit and Ambition: The Canadian Fur Trade, 1779-1821

Don't let the painting by Frances Ann Hopkins fool you, *Profit and Ambition* is an exhibition on the North West Company's fur trading activities between 1779 and 1821. The exhibition opened at the Canadian Museum of Civilization on 11 September, and will be showing there until 12 September 2010. Some 250 artefacts and works of art are on display, including trade goods, original documents, Native and European garments, and a birchbark

European garments, and a birchbark Montreal canoe measuring ten meters long.

A Modern-Day Voyageur Family

3,000 Mile Fur Trade Canoe Route Across the U.S. and Canada, chronicles a family undertaking that lasted fifteen consecutive summers and took them from Montreal to Lake Athabasca. Inspired by their French ancestors' participation in the fur trade, the Kents became well-versed in fur trade history, canoe-tripping and outdoor survival; this knowledge is transmitted to the reader through narrative, history and anecdotes.
